

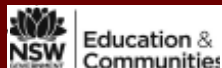

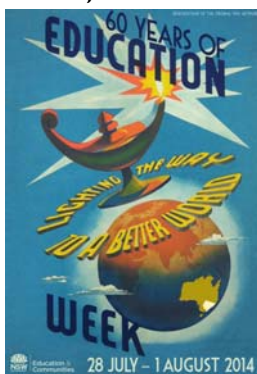

P&C Meeting: Change of Date

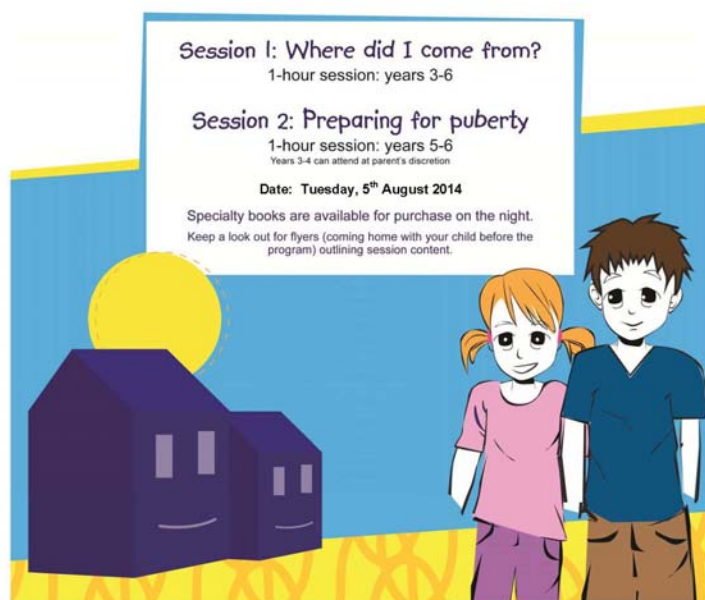

Notes to Teacher

There have been lots of notes going out to students asking for notification as to their absence. Parents have been writing on these notes that they have notified or spoken to the teacher. Just so you are aware we **always** need written notification. If you are going to be away for a week or more you need to fill out an exemption form. These forms can be obtained in our office or from our website. If your child is away for a day or two, just send a sick note in with them the day that they return. If they are away for 3 days or more you need to ring and notify the school as to why your child is absent, but this still needs to be followed up with a note on their return. If we do not receive a note your child's absence goes down as an unjustified absence. Thank you for your understanding.
