Excellence

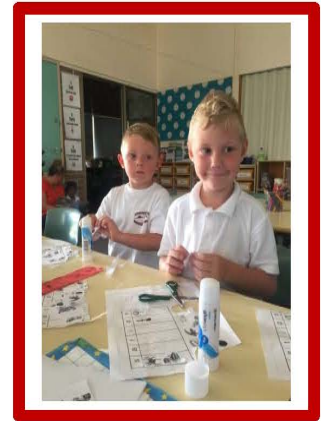
