BUS INFORMATION – ROAD WORKS

Port Stephens coaches have let us know that there is some road works scheduled from Monday 3/9/18 for approx. 3 weeks. Port Stephens Council will be conducting roadworks on Church St in Nelson Bay where a single lane of traffic will be allowed to flow in a northern direction ONLY. As a result of these works, two transit stops will not be able to be serviced;




And the reading continues.... Book Club Issue 6 went home last week, packed full of bargains and great books to read... This issue closes on September 7.
