CONGRATUALTIONS - NEWCASTLE PERMANENT MATHS AWARDS

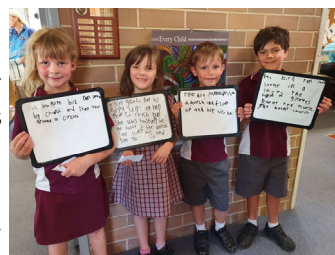
