## NEWSLETTER 2

Tomaree Road | May 2019



### Road improvement works along Tomaree Road to begin shortly.

#### Project background

In late March 2019 a community drop in session regarding the Tomaree Road project was held. Since this drop in session the extent or scope of the works has changed.

#### Scope changes

Council will soon be working on Tomaree Road between the Rigney Street intersection and Fingal Street intersection.

The scope for these works has been restricted simply due to the amount of funding available. This project was to be boosted by some additional funding related to the Special Rate Variation proposal, however as this funding is now not available the works will need to be staged to allow the full completion of the road reconstruction of Tomaree Road. Please see the map overlaid to help explain these scope changes.

Despite these scope changes the project remains a significant investment in both the road and drainage networks of Shoal Bay.

The drainage network improvements are an important step towards improving drainage in Shoal Bay. There is limited space in Shoal Bay for traditional style drainage ie drainage easements and large scale stormwater pipe network. Therefore, other technologies based on Water Sensitive Urban Design principles need to be retrofitted to the area.

The improved stormwater drainage system will include infiltration pipes and underground stormwater storage chambers to be installed in the Garden Place reserve. The infiltration drainage system will reduce flooding problems on downstream properties. The system will also ultimately improve the water quality at Shoal Bay Beach through the reduction of pollutants and erosion.

#### Kerb and gutter contributions

Kerb and gutter will be installed primarily on the Shoal Bay Public School side of Tomaree Road. The new footpath will also be installed on the same side of

Tomaree Road. There is no contribution required from residents for the footpath component. Letters detailing the kerb and gutter contributions will soon be sent out to home owners directly.

The kerb and gutter contribution depends on the width of the frontage of the property and the position of the property as corner blocks pay a reduced rate.

The current rate for property frontage is \$69.00 per lineal metre and for corner properties is \$46.50 per lineal metre. Payment plans are available if required.

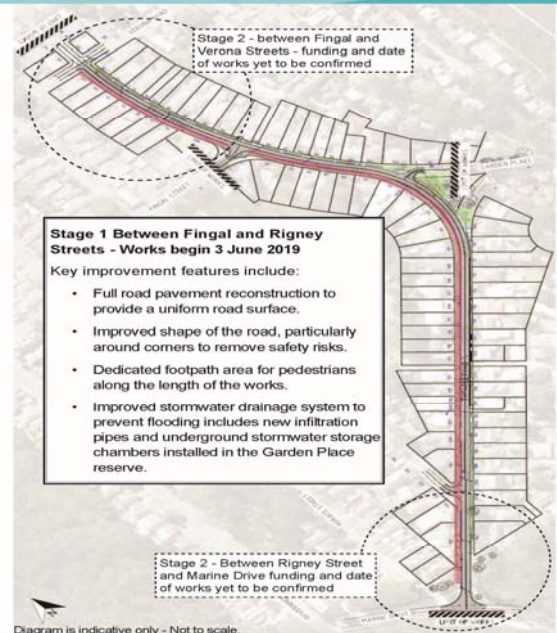
#### During works

Tomaree Road, between Rigney Street and Fingal Street, including Garden Place to the Essendine Road intersection, will be closed to all non-residential traffic for the duration of the works.

Buses will be diverted down Rigney Street from the Marine Drive end. Every effort will be made to minimise disruption to traffic movement where possible.

#### Keeping up to date

#### Stage 1 Between Fingal and Rigney Streets - Works begin 3 June 2019

Key improvement features include:

- Full road pavement reconstruction to provide a uniform road surface.
- Improved shape of the road, particularly around corners to remove safety risks.
- Dedicated footpath area for pedestrians along the length of the works.
- Improved stormwater drainage system to prevent flooding includes new infiltration pipes and underground stormwater storage chambers installed in the Garden Place reserve.

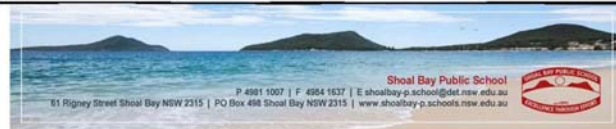

## SHOAL BAY PUBLIC SCHOOL LEADERSHIP POLICY

### Aim:

to provide guidelines for the school procedure for eligibility, nominations and procedures for electing school leaders.

### Policy:

The selection of school leaders will take place in November each year.

There are 8 positions available for 4 girls and 4 boys.

Only students from Year 5 are eligible for selection for these positions.

Year 5 students must be nominated by their peers (and seconded) to stand for election.

Only those students who have participated in the Year 5 playground leadership program are eligible for selection.

Nominated children will be informed that they should be respected by peers and teachers, model excellent behaviour, display school spirit, be willing to participate in many activities, be able to speak in public and give up some lunch times for responsibilities.

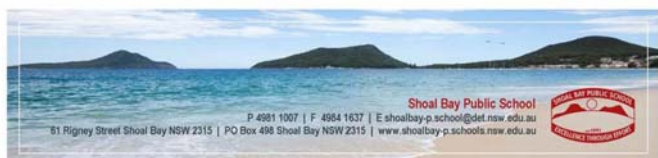
Children who have been sent to thinking room/ supervisor twice or have been suspended or expelled within the voting year are ineligible for selection.

Nominated children will present an election speech to the voters (students in years 2-5)

Voting will be by secret ballot. The top 4 number of votes will determine the 4 boys and 4 girls to become parliamentarians.

The staff will then vote (secret ballot) for the 2 children from the 8 who will become the premiers of the school.

The school principal and executive have the right of veto. This will only be used in exceptional circumstances.
