## Keep the lunchbox cool

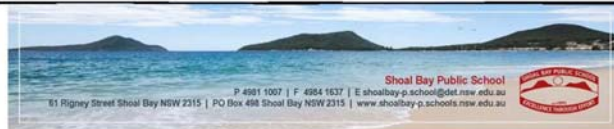
Want to pack cold foods like yoghurt and cheese but worried about food safety?
