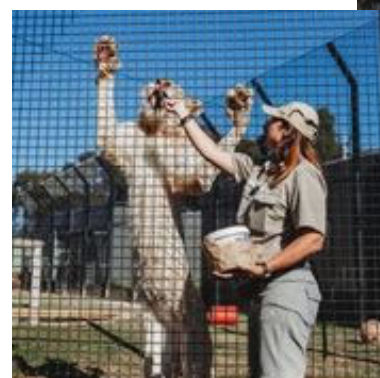
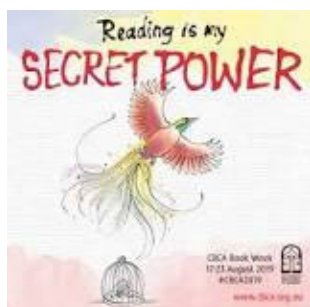
She will be running fun drawing workshops for all students from K – 6 and has also agreed to read a secret book at lunchtime as our very first guest reader for the week.
